The August meeting of the Dougherty Circuit Bar Association will be held at Merry Acres Restaurant on August 25, 1995 at 12:30 p.m. Please call 435-1470 by noon on August 23 with your reservations.

In other news, in response to input received at the June meeting of the Association, Judge Salter announces revisions for the scheduling of civil and criminal cases as follows: Civil calendar calls will be held at 9:00 a.m. on September 6 for the October term and November 8 for the December term. Pretrial dates will take place on September 18 through 20 for the October term, and November 20 through 21 for the December term. The trial term for October will be the 16th through the 20th and for December the 11th through the 15th.

For Criminal cases, the calendar calls will take place on September 5 for the October term and November 1 for the December term. Attorneys are encouraged by Judge Salter to avoid these calendar calls by informing District Attorney Dick Hand of requests for bench trial and providing jury trial waivers prior to the call of the calendar. Criminal pre-trials will take place on September 25 through 28 for the October term and November 27 through 29 for the December term. Bench trials will take place on October 9 through 11 and December 4 through 6. Criminal jury trials will take place October 23 through 26 and December 18 through 21. Criminal arraignments are scheduled each Tuesday and Thursday for jail cases and each Friday at 8:30 in room 300 for non-jail cases, except during State Court Civil trial weeks and the first weeks of Superior Court trial term. Revocation hearings will take place at 1:00 p.m. every Thursday at the jail except during State Court jury trial weeks. Please note these on your calendars. Thanks to Judge Salter for sharing this information to be relayed to the members of the Association.

For all attorneys handling appellate work, please note that the Court of Appeals, effective August 1, 1995, has amended Rules 38, 4, 5 and 15. Rule 38 pertains to Certiorari; Rule 4 pertains to filing of documents; Rule 5 pertains to costs; and Rule 15 pertains to penalties.
